



Land Rights Policy

Suncream Dairies Ltd rely on large quantities of agricultural raw materials. Some crops, for example, but not limited to, sugar and palm oil have been the source of land acquisitions and conflicts to the detriment of small food producers. This has in turn been linked to human rights violations, poverty and hunger for some individual, their families and communities.

The aim of Suncream Dairies is to be a fair and responsible manufacturer. In recognition of all of these factors, Suncream Dairies Ltd as a small manufacturer, can only influence a fair land rights policy by ensuring their supply chain conform to honourable and transparent practices surrounding the land used for the growing of raw materials purchased.

Specifically, it is expected for the land associated with the raw materials purchased that there is:

1. Zero tolerance for land displacement of any indigenous population or individuals.
2. Fair and legal negotiations for land transfers and acquisitions.
3. All land acquisitions meet IFC Performance Standards and UN FAO Voluntary Guidelines

Suncream Dairies Ltd through their Supplier Code of Practice have communicated these expectations to their supply chain.
